### Eligible diagnoses for chart submissions based on practice specialty

#### A. Primary Care:

1. Diabetic Retinopathy (E11.319, E08.355, E10.319, E11.355, E11.321, E11.331, E11.351, E11.329, E11.339, E11.349, E11.341, E13.331 (not comprehensive list)
2. Primary Open Angle Glaucoma (H40.11) or high risk Glaucoma Suspect (H40.0, H40.01-, H40.02-)
3. A chart that had been coded 99213 within the past 6 months (any diagnosis)

#### B. Contact Lens:

1. Dry Eye (H04.129), Punctate Keratitis (370.21, K. Sicca (H16.149), Blepharitis (H01.00-)
2. Regular Astigmatism (H52.223)
3. A chart that had been coded 99213 within the past 6 months.

#### C. Pediatrics/Vision Therapy/Pediatric Rehabilitation:

1. Convergence Insufficiency (H51.1), Convergence Excess (H51.12), or Accommodative Dysfunction (H52.529, H52.539)
2. Amblyopia (Strabismic H53.03 or Refractive H53.02)
3. A chart that had been coded 99213 within the past 6 months (any diagnosis)

#### D. Low Vision / Pediatric Practices that only see children with disabilities

1. Diabetic Retinopathy (E11.319, E08.355, E10.319, E11.355, E11.321, E11.331, E11.351, E11.329, E11.339, E11.349, E11.341, E13.331 (not comprehensive list)

3. A chart that would have been coded 99213 within the past 6 months (any diagnosis)

**For Contact Lens, please supply ONE copy of a complete eye exam for each category below:**

1. A patient with Dry Eye (H04.129), Punctate Keratitis (370.21) or K. Sicca (H16.149) (may include Blepharitis (H01.00-) if difficult to find the first 3) in or close to **March 2023**
2. A patient with Regular Astigmatism (H52.223) in or close to **June 2023**
3. A chart that had been coded **99213 within the past 6 months.**

**For Pediatrics/Vision Therapy/Pediatric Rehabilitation, please supply ONE copy of a complete eye exam for each category below:**

1. A patient with Convergence Insufficiency (H51.1)/Convergence Excess (H51.12) or Accommodative Dysfunction (H52.529, H52.539) in or close to **March 2023**
2. A patient with Amblyopia (Strabismic H53.03 or Refractive H53.02) in or close to **June 2023**
3. A chart that had been coded **99213 within the past 6 months.**

**For Low Vision, please supply ONE copy of a Consultation exam (i.e. a 45-60 minute exam, not a follow up) for:**

1. Consultation related to Diabetic Retinopathy (E11.319, E08.355, E10.319, E11.355, E11.321, E11.331, E11.351, E11.329, E11.339, E11.349, E11.341, E13.331 (not comprehensive list)) in or close to **March 2023**

2. Consultation related to Age-related Macular Degeneration (H35.31, H35.32) in or close to **June 2023**

3. A chart that would have been coded **99213 within the past 6 months.**
